DETAILS OF THE LANCASTER COUNTY FARM AND HOME FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS – 2024

A. Lancaster County Farm & Home Foundation Scholarships will support Lancaster County students pursuing post-secondary agriculture and family consumer science education to prepare students for successful careers and a lifetime of informed choices in the global agriculture, food, fiber, natural and renewable resources systems. As defined by The National FFA Organization, "Agricultural education is a systematic program of instruction available to students desiring to learn about the science, business, and technology of plant and animal production and/or about the environmental and natural resources systems."

B. Amount and Details of Each Scholarship Award:

- Each scholarship award will be in the amount of \$1,000.00 per year renewable for up to four years. The scholarship will be payable jointly through the university, college or other accredited institute of higher learning, in equal installments at the beginning of each semester. In order to be renewed, the recipients must continue to major in an agriculture related field as referenced in Section A and maintain a grade point average of 3.0 or better. A student who maintains eligibility, but completes a degree in less than 8 semesters is not guaranteed the maximum \$4,000.00.
- 2. This scholarship award may be used to help defray tuition, fees, or room and board expenses at any accredited institute of higher learning which offers courses of study in agriculture-related education as referenced in Section A.

C. <u>Applicant Eligibility Requirements</u>:

- 1. Senior students in public, non-public, homeschool, and cyber high schools in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, who are also residents of Lancaster County or Lancaster County residents who have completed high school training and beginning their post-secondary education by December 1st of the application year are eligible.
- 2. Applicants must meet scholastic and other entrance requirements for an accredited program in either Agriculture or Family and Consumer Science at an accredited college, university, or other accredited institutes of higher education.
- 3. Family members of Scholarship Committee members on the Farm and Home Foundation's Board of Directors are not eligible.

D. <u>Basis of Selection:</u>

1. Applicants must complete and submit the attached application form, along with a transcript of their high school scholastic records on or before 5:00 p.m. on <u>Monday, April 15, 2024</u> to:

- Applicants must obtain a <u>statement</u> from their Guidance Counselor or their High School Principal, regarding their leadership ability, and character and have it <u>mailed</u> or emailed <u>under separate cover</u> to the Farm and Home Foundation, by the same deadline as listed above.
- 3. Selection of winners will be based upon scholastic achievement, and leadership ability and agriculture-related activities, and financial need. Selections to be made by the Board of Directors of the Lancaster County Farm and Home Foundation, based upon the screening, evaluation, and recommendations of the Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Finalists will be invited for an interview before the Foundation Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors on Tuesday, May 21, 2024.
- 5. Winners will be notified and a public announcement made by Wednesday, May 22, 2024.
